

POLICY STATEMENT AND REGULATIONS

ADOPT-A-TRAIL PROGRAM

The Corporation of the District of Summerland is promoting a private/public partnership in the form of an "Adopt-a-Trail" program giving private organizations, clubs and community groups the opportunity to assist the municipality in keeping Summerland beautiful by volunteering their labour to pick up the litter and debris along the sides of local trails.

REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES

1. The Adopt-a-Trail Program will be administered by the Parks & Recreation Department under the direction of the Recreation Director.
2. Participants will be required to provide the information outlined on the Adopt-A-Trail application attached to this policy as Schedule A and further to commit to the conditions of the program by signing the application form.
3. Participants will be required to sign a 'Release of All Claims and Waiver of Liability' attached to this policy as Schedule B.
4. The District of Summerland will:
 - Provide garbage bags for work bees.
 - Supply safety vests upon request.
 - Pick up full garbage bags the next working day.
 - Provide third party liability insurance coverage for registered volunteers under the District of Summerland general insurance policy.
 - Install and maintain an "Adopt-a-Trail" sign which displays the name of the organization volunteering in this area upon completion of first cleaning.
 - Notify all volunteers, in writing, of any changes to the program.
